1. Indian-origin artist Anish Kapoor tops 'Hurun India Art List 2024' I

London-based Indian-origin artist Anish Kapoor has topped the Hurun India Art List for the sixth consecutive year. The list is released by the Hurun Research Institute, ranking the top 50 living Indian artists based on works sold at public auctions as of January 1, 2024. Anas Rahman Junaid, Managing Director and Chief Researcher, Hurun Report India, said that the demand for Indian art is increasing and the Hurun India Art List 2024 is proof of this.



2. Recently Dr. Emmanuelle Soubeyran was elected as the new Director-General of the World Organization for Animal Health. Paris, May 28, 2024 – The World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) has elected Dr. Emmanuelle Soubeyran as Director-General for 2024-2029 during its 91st Ordinary Session. Following the "one country, one vote" rule, WOAH delegates elected her via secret ballot to lead the organization's next chapter. Thus, Dr. Soubeyran became the 8th Director-General of WOAH.



3. Agnikul Cosmos' Agnibaan is the world's first 3D printed space rocket engine.

Space startup Agnikul Cosmos successfully launched its SOrTeD mission on May 30. The mission is a demonstration of a single-stage launch vehicle powered by a semi-cryogenic 3D-printed engine and is a major milestone in the development of Indian indigenous space technology. The mission, initially scheduled to launch on April 7, was postponed due to technical glitches. It was finally launched from India's first private launchpad, ALP-01, located at Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.



4. Goa State Day 2024 I

The beautiful state of Goa located on the west coast of India celebrates Goa State Day every year on 30 May with great pomp. In 1976, the Goa Legislative Assembly passed a resolution demanding full statehood for Goa. As a result, on 30 May 1987, Goa got full statehood and became the 25th state of India. Since then, Goa State Day celebrations are celebrated with great enthusiasm every year on 30 May. The history of Goa is linked to Portuguese rule. Goa was part of Portugal till the year 1961.





5. NSE Index launches India's first EV index

NSE Index Limited, a subsidiary of NSE, has launched the country's first electric vehicle (EV) index, called the Nifty EV and New Age Automotive Index. The index will track the performance of companies that are part of the EV ecosystem or are involved in developing new-age automotive vehicles or related technologies.

8. Sophie Ecclestone became the fastest female cricketer to complete 100 ODI wickets, achieving this feat in just 47 ODIs. England women's team left-arm spinner Sophie Ecclestone set the record for the fastest 100 ODI wickets in the third and final T20I match of the series against Pakistan women's team. Ecclestone took three wickets for 15 runs in 4.1 overs and completed 100 wickets in her ODI career. She achieved this feat in just 64 matches, equalling the record of Australia's Katherine Fitzpatrick and surpassing the record in terms of number of wickets bowled (63).

There are four major varieties of tobacco in India: flue-cured Virginia (FCV) tobacco, bidi tobacco, cigar filler tobacco, hookah and chewing tobacco.


