1. World Bicycle Day 2024 |

According to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index, Gautam Adani has a net worth of \$111 billion, making him the 11th richest person in the world. Mukesh Ambani, on the other hand, has a net worth of \$109 billion, placing him at the 12th spot globally.



3. International Sex Workers Day 2024 |

On June 2, 2024, the world celebrates International Sex Workers Day, dedicated to raising awareness of the challenges and exploitation faced by sex workers. The day underlines the need for healthy working conditions, respect, and human rights for those engaged in the sex industry. International Sex Workers Day began on June 2, 1975, in the French city of Lyon, when about 100 sex workers gathered at the Saint-Nizier Church.



4. Dinesh Karthik announces retirement from cricket

Senior wicketkeeper-batsman Dinesh Karthik has announced his retirement from all forms of cricket. The recently concluded Indian Premier League (IPL) season saw his emotional farewell from the Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) franchise. In his international career, Karthik scored 3463 runs in a total of 180 matches, including one Test century and 17 half-centuries. He also performed brilliantly in wicketkeeping, with 172 dismissals to his name.



5. Telangana Formation Day I

Telangana Formation Day is celebrated on June 2, which commemorates the formation of the Indian state of Telangana. Telangana was established as the 28th state of India on June 2, 2014, a result of years of struggle and aspirations. Telangana has a rich cultural heritage and special identity. However, it was a part of Andhra Pradesh for a long time, and the people there believed that their development needs and cultural peculiarities were not properly recognised. This led to the demand for a separate state.



6. Tanvi Sharma wins Bonn International Badminton Tournament women's singles title

Indian badminton player Tanvi Sharma won the Bonn International tournament title by defeating Wang Pei Yu of Chinese Taipei in two games. She is ranked 181 in the Indian rankings, but this win proved the mettle of her game. In the match, she was on top after defeating the Chinese player 21-19, 22-20. Tanvi's first important title has made her a topic of discussion in the Indian badminton community. Other Indian players who were a part of this tournament did not succeed in their game.



7. Boxer Amit Panghal secured Paris Olympics quota in men's 51 kg category

Indian boxer Amit Panghal secured Olympic quota for the Paris Games with his excellent performance. He defeated China's Chuang Liu 5-0 in the decisive quarterfinal bout at the second World Qualification Tournament. With this win, he gave India a proud chance to get an opportunity at the Olympics. Panghal's win puts him in the exclusive group of India who have already qualified for the Olympics, such as Nishant Dev, Nikhat Zareen, Preeti Pawar, and Lovlina Borgohain.



8. June 3 World Clubfoot Day I

June 3 is celebrated as World Clubfoot Day, which is important for the treatment of clubfoot. This day is celebrated to commemorate the birthday of Dr. Ignacio Ponseti, the developer of the Ponseti method. Clubfoot is a musculoskeletal congenital deformity, which affects millions of newborns every year. This deformity is found in more than 80 percent of developing countries. According to Ponseti International, clubfoot affects the physical development of children, causing them problems with naming and gait.
