1. Claudia Sheinbaum becomes first female president, Mexico creates history I

Mexico has created history by electing Claudia Sheinbaum as the country's first female president, according to provisional results announced by Mexico's election commission.

Sheinbaum, as the candidate of the ruling Morena party, beat her closest rivals in the presidential election held on June 2, 2024. Outgoing President Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador, who is a supporter of Sheinbaum, has congratulated her on her victory.



2. International Day against Violence against Children 2024

Every year, the International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression is observed on June 4. In 2024, the day is being observed on Tuesday. The day began on August 19, 1982, when a special session of the United Nations General Assembly focused on the plight of Palestinian and Lebanese children affected by Israeli aggression during the Lebanon War. At that time, the General Assembly resolved to protect the rights of children in Lebanon and declared that the day would be observed every year on June 4.



3. India's Ruchira Kamboj announces retirement from the United Nations.

Senior diplomat Ruchira Kamboj, a 1987 batch officer of the Indian Foreign Service, concludes a remarkable career by retiring on June 1, 2024. She was born on 3 May 1964. She topped the civil services exam and began her diplomatic career as Third Secretary and Second Secretary in the Indian Embassy in France. She held important positions as India's Permanent Representative to UNESCO in Paris, High Commissioner to South Africa and the first woman Ambassador to Bhutan.



4. Real Madrid created history by winning UEFA Champions League for the 15th time.

Real Madrid created history once again by winning their 15th UEFA Champions League title at Wembley Stadium. The Spanish giants displayed their traditional tenacity and resourcefulness to beat Borussia Dortmund 2-0. Dortmund dominated the match for the first hour and created several scoring chances, especially in the first half.



5. Halla Tomasdottir becomes new President of Iceland

Iceland has taken a historic step when it elected businesswoman Halla Tomasdottir as its new President. This makes her the second woman to hold this high position. She won 34.3% of the vote, beating former Prime Ministers Katrin Jakobsdottir and Halla Hrund Laugadottir. Tomasdottir, who comes with business experience, is well-known for her support of climate change. Her victory has promoted new thinking about traditional political personalities.



6. Nayana James won gold medal at Taiwan Athletics Open 2024

Nayana James won gold medal in women's long jump event at Taiwan Athletics Open 2024. She finished first in the championship held in Chinese Taipei by recording an impressive distance of 6.43 meters despite incessant rain. Sumire Hata won the silver medal with a distance of 6.37 meters. Yu Jeongmei won the bronze medal with a jump of 6.14 meters. On the other hand, Ankesh Chaudhary won the gold medal in the men's 800 meters race, compatriot Somnath Chauhan won the silver medal.
