1. Prime Minister Modi took oath as Prime Minister for the third time |

Prime Minister Narendra Modi took oath as Prime Minister for the third consecutive time, making him the second politician in the country to make this record after Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. President Draupadi Murmu administered the oath of office and secrecy to him at Rashtrapati Bhavan. After him, many former Union Ministers including Rajnath Singh and Jaishankar once again took oath as ministers.

3. Eenadu Group and Ramoji Film City founder Ramoji Rao passes away at the age of 88 |

Eenadu Group and Ramoji Film City founder Ramoji Rao passed away in Hyderabad, Telangana on the morning of June 8 at the age of 88. He was undergoing treatment at Star Hospital in Hyderabad and breathed his last at 3:45 am. He was not well for the last few days and was undergoing treatment at the hospital. The Telangana Chief Minister's Office has announced that Ramoji Rao will be cremated with state honours.



4. Iga Swiatek wins women's singles title for the third time in a row |

Iga Swiatek of Poland won her third title by defeating Jasmine Paolini of Italy in the French Open tennis women's singles final. Swiatek had entered the match as the favorite, as she had won all the previous Grand Slams including the US Open in 2022 and the French Open at Roland-Garros in 2020, 2022 and 2023. Paolini got the first break in the first game, but the match soon turned and Swiatek regained her rhythm by asserting herself. Swiatek dominated the second set by getting an early break.



5. Chandrababu Naidu to take oath as Andhra Pradesh CM on June 12 |

Chandrababu Naidu's Telugu Desam Party (TDP) has performed brilliantly in the Andhra Pradesh Assembly and Lok Sabha elections. The TDP-BJP-Janaseena alliance has won a majority in the assembly elections, with the TDP winning 135 of the 144 seats. This landslide victory will make Chandrababu Naidu the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh for the third time. He plans to take oath on June 12. Naidu first took oath as Chief Minister in 1995, and has held the post twice more since then.



6. World Accreditation Day 2024 |

World Accreditation Day, which is celebrated every year on June 9, is an important occasion governed by the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (ILAC). The day aims to promote business, as well as address environmental, health, and safety concerns. The current year 2024 theme of World Accreditation Day is "Accreditation: Empowering Tomorrow and Shaping the Future".



7. Puja Tomar first Indian to win a fight in Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) |

Puja Tomar created history by becoming the first Indian to win a fight in the Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC) by defeating Brazil's Ryan dos Santos at UFC Louisville 2024. Pooja had set a new record last year by becoming the first Indian woman to get a UFC contract. Both fighters performed with full strength. In her first fight in the women's strawweight division, she won by split decision with scores of 30-27, 27-30 and 29-28.

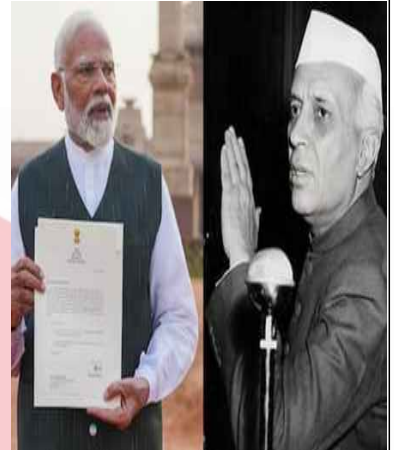
