1. Malawi's Vice President dies in plane crash |

Malawi's Vice President Saulos Chilima, his wife and nine others died in a plane crash when the plane they were travelling in crashed into the Chikungwa mountain range. President Lazarus Chakwera declared a national day of mourning following the tragic incident. After the crash, the wreckage of the military plane carrying the vice president was found in the northern mountainous region of the country. President Chakwera confirmed in a live address on state television that no one survived the crash.



2. Chandrababu Naidu declares Amaravati as the sole capital of Andhra Pradesh |

A day before taking oath as the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh, Telugu Desam Party (TDP) chief Chandrababu Naidu announced that Amaravati will be the sole capital of the state. He made the announcement during a joint meeting of TDP, BJP and Janasena MLAs on Tuesday, where he was unanimously elected as the NDA leader in the Andhra Pradesh Assembly. At the meeting, Naidu made it clear that the three capitals plan will not be implemented during his government and only Amaravati will be the state capital.



3. Appointment of Lieutenant General Upendra Dwivedi as Army Chief |

Lieutenant General Upendra Dwivedi has been appointed as the next Army Chief of India. He will replace General Manoj Pandey, who is retiring on June 30. Currently Lieutenant General Dwivedi is serving as the Vice-Chief of the Army. In his appointment, the government has followed the principle of seniority. The Defense Ministry issued a statement saying that his appointment will be effective from the afternoon of June 30.



4. World Day Against Child Labor 2024 |

World Day Against Child Labor is organized every year on 12 June. The main objective of this day is to promote the global movement against child labor. According to the United Nations, people and governments need to focus on the root causes and promote social justice to end child labor. Child labor inhibits the physical and mental development of children and deprives them of educational opportunities. This year, the theme of World Day Against Child Labor is - "Let's Act on Our Commitments: End Child Labor!".



5. Prem Singh Tamang sworn in as Sikkim Chief Minister |

On June 10, Prem Singh Tamang Golay assumed the office of Chief Minister of Sikkim. He took the oath of office, which is an important moment for Sikkim. He was sworn in by Governor Laxman Prasad Acharya at the Paljor Stadium. With seven new faces in the cabinet, he also showed his development program plan. In this election, after the historic victory of Sikkim Krantikari Morcha (SKM), Prem Singh Tamang Golay maintained his local prestige by becoming the Chief Minister for the second consecutive time.



6. Bindra, an IRS officer, now appointed as CCI secretary |

Indian Revenue Service officer Indrapal Singh Bindra will soon take over as the secretary of the Competition Commission of India (CCI). Bindra will replace IRS officer Anupama Anand, who has resigned within eight months of joining the regulator. Bindra's tenure at the CCI is scheduled for a period of three years from the date of his assuming charge. He has been tasked with monitoring and curbing unfair business practices at the CCI.



7. International Albinism Awareness Day 2024 |

International Albinism Awareness Day is observed every year on 13 June. The main objective of this day is to raise awareness among people about albinism and the human rights of persons suffering from it. Various programs and awareness campaigns are organized on this occasion, the main objective of which is education and respect for persons affected by albinism. This day also provides an important platform against all types of human rights violations.



8. India's Gulveer Singh won silver medal at Portland Track Festival High-Performance Meet |

Indian sprinter Gulveer Singh won the silver medal in the men's 5000m race at the Portland Track Festival High Performance Athletics Meet held in the US. With this important victory, he became the fastest runner among Indian runners. He recorded a time of thirteen minutes, eighteen point, nine two seconds in this race, which is a national record for Indian runners. Gulveer achieved this feat by breaking the record of Avinash Sable last year.
