1. Pema Khandu sworn in as Arunachal Pradesh CM for the third time |

On June 13, 2024, Pema Khandu took oath as the Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh as a Bharatiya Janata Party leader in a ceremony attended by prominent leaders including Union Home Minister Amit Shah, BJP president JP Nadda, Union minister Kiren Rijiju and Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma. Governor Lt Gen (retd) K T Parnaik administered the oath to Khandu and eleven cabinet ministers.



2. Appointment of Ajit Doval as National Security Advisor (NSA) |

The central government on June 13 re-appointed former IPS officer Ajit Doval as the National Security Advisor (NSA). His appointment will end with the term of Prime Minister Narendra Modi or continue until further orders. Ajit Doval (born 20 January 1945) is a former spy and the current NSA of India. He was the head of the Intelligence Bureau (IB) and a former IPS officer of Kerala cadre.

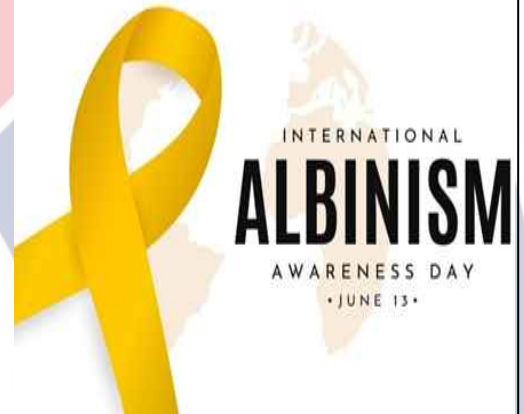
5. Prem Prabhakar appointed MD & CEO of SBICAP Ventures Ltd.

Shruti Vora has created a new history in equestrian by becoming the first Indian rider to win a three-star Grand Prix event. Shruti and her horse Magnanimous scored 67.761 points in the CDI-3 event of the FEI Dressage World Cup held in Lipica, Slovenia. In this competition, she beat Tatiana Antonenko of Moldova, who scored 66.552 points.
