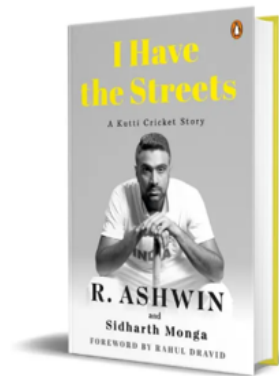
## 5. Pawan Kalyan appointed as Andhra Pradesh Deputy CM

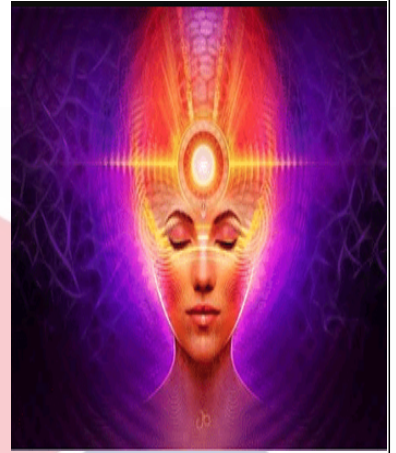

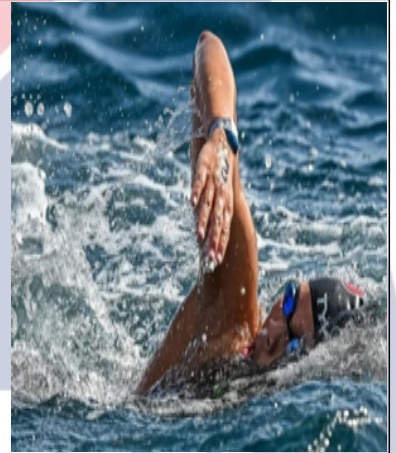

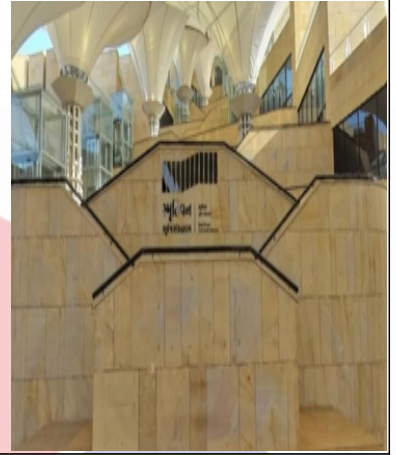
