India's equity market has once again overtaken Hong Kong to become the world's fourth largest in terms of market capitalisation. India's market value has risen to \$5.2 trillion, including a 10% rise after the election. In contrast, Hong Kong's market value has fallen 5.4% from its peak this year to \$5.17 trillion. This change is significant in the global market rankings and reflects India's strong economic fundamentals and investor confidence.

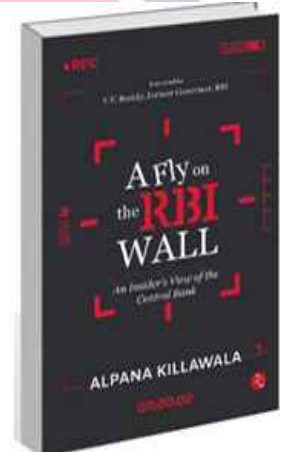
3. Kavli Prize 2024: Honoring significant achievements in astrophysics, nanoscience and neuroscience

The average level of global peace in 2024 has deteriorated by 0.56%, which shows a decline in peace for the fifth year. This year 65 countries have improved peace while 97 countries saw a decline in peace.
