1. Pat Cummins took the first hat-trick of this T20 World Cup.

Australia's fast bowler Pat Cummins took the first hat-trick of this tournament against Bangladesh in the Super Eight stage match of the T20 World Cup. 31-year-old Cummins dismissed Mahmudullah and Mehdi Hasan on the last two balls of the 18th over. After this, he sent Tauheed Hridaya to the pavilion on the first ball of the last over. This was the seventh hat-trick taken in the T20 World Cup.



2. UNHCR names Theo James as its new Goodwill Ambassador.

On this important day of global humanitarian efforts, the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) has appointed British actor Theo James as its new Goodwill Ambassador. The appointment is an important step towards amplifying the voices of displaced people around the world. Theo James has a personal connection to the role, as his grandfather fled from Greece to Syria during World War II.

6. Trent Boult retires from international cricket I

New Zealand left-arm fast bowler Trent Boult announced his retirement from international cricket after New Zealand's final Group C match against Papua New Guinea in the 2024 T20 ICC Cricket World Cup. The match was played at the Brian Lara Stadium in Tarouba. In his final international match, Boult took two wickets for 14 runs as New Zealand bowled out Papua New Guinea for just 78 runs.



7. World Rainforest Day 2024 I

World Rainforest Day (June 22) aims to raise awareness of the importance of rainforests and their conservation. This international event was founded by the Rainforest Partnership, an Austin, Texas-based non-profit organization. Rainforests harbor 80% of the world's terrestrial biodiversity, they shelter a diverse species of plants and animals, and provide homes for indigenous groups.

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved a Rs 2870 crore project for the development of Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport in Varanasi. 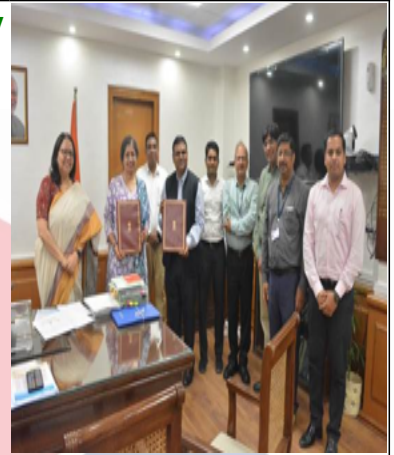

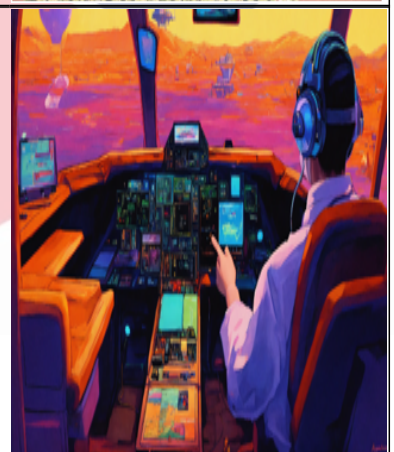
