1. Amit Shah inaugurates 'FTI-TTP' at Terminal-3 of Delhi Airport

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Shri Amit Shah inaugurated the 'Fast Track Immigration - Trusted Traveller Programme' (FTI-TTP) at Terminal-3 of Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi on 22 June. Union Home Secretary and several other dignitaries were present on the occasion.

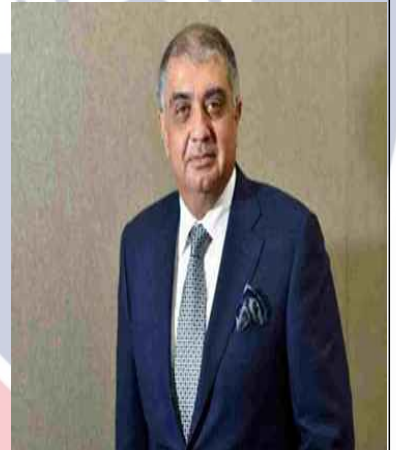

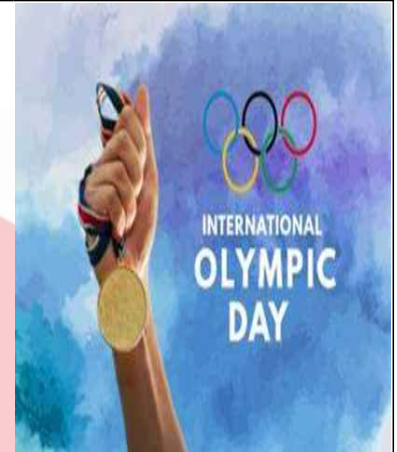
