5. NCPCR declares mica mines in Jharkhand 'child labour-free'

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) declared mica mines in Jharkhand as 'child labour-free' at an event held in Koderma, Jharkhand on July 5, 2024. NCPCR Chairperson Priyank Kanungo said that this is the first successful attempt to end the supply chain of child labour in mica mining in the country. Working children up to the age of 14 years in India are called child labourers.



6. Union Minister Piyush Goyal announces concession in licensing fee

To promote entrepreneurship, Union Minister Piyush Goyal has announced a reduction in license fee by 80% for women entrepreneurs and 50% for MSMEs under the Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organisation (PESO). The initiative aims to encourage greater participation of women and MSMEs in the petroleum and explosives sector, thereby striking a balance between industry compliance and public safety.



7. Gagan Narang announced as new Chief-de-Mission at Paris Olympics 2024

The Indian Olympic Association (IOA) has appointed Gagan Narang, bronze medallist in the 2012 Olympic Games men's 10m air rifle event, as the Chef-de-Mission of the Indian contingent at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. He will replace MC Mary Kom. Gagan Narang is a four-time Olympian and his appointment will give the Indian contingent strong leadership support.



8. Dhruv Sitwala and Anupama Ramachandran win Asian Billiards and Snooker chips.

India's Dhruv Sitwala and Anupama Ramachandran have won the men's Asian Billiards and women's snooker titles at the Asian Championships in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. Dhruv Sitwala won the title by defeating his compatriot Pankaj Advani. Sitwala had earlier won the Asian Billiards titles in 2015 and 2016 as well, making this his third Asian Billiards title. Anupama Ramachandran won her first international title by defeating Thailand's Panchaya Channoi.

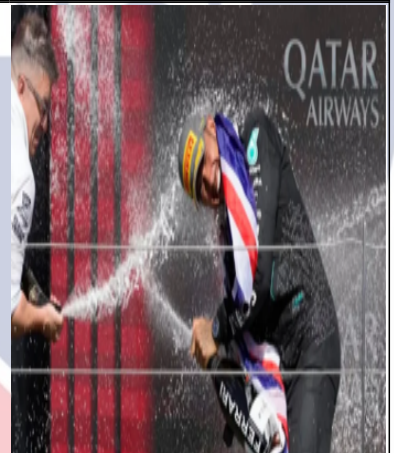
