1. Sheinbaum becomes Mexico's first female president.

Mexico has elected a female president for the first time. Claudia Sheinbaum, who was the candidate of the ruling Morena party, has taken a decisive lead over her rivals. According to provisional results from the Mexican Election Commission, Sheinbaum received 58.3% to 60.7% of the vote, while her main opposition candidate Xochitl Galvez received 26.6% to 28.6% of the vote and the third candidate Jorge Alvarez Menez received 9.9% to 10.8% of the vote.



2. Who is Vice Admiral Aarti Sareen? Became the first woman Director General of AFMS.

Surgeon Vice Admiral Aarti Sareen made history by taking over as the Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAFMS) as she became the first woman officer to be appointed to this post. In her career spanning 38 years, she has held several important appointments such as DG Medical Services (Navy), DG Medical Services (Air), and Director and Commandant of AFMC Pune.

The day is celebrated in over 100 countries, and aims to honour teachers, promote international solidarity, and emphasise the importance of quality of education. 4. PM Modi inaugurates Gaushala with Bio-CNG plant in Madhya Pradesh.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated the bio-CNG plant of Lal Tipra Gaushala in Gwalior and launched various development projects worth Rs 685 crore in Madhya Pradesh. The inauguration coincided with Swachhata Diwas on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, which is celebrated every year on October 2. Gwalior's bio-CNG plant has been set up in collaboration with Indian Oil Corporation (IOC).



5. Federal Bank joins hands with Bhashini to add local language support to chatbot Feddy.

Feddy Bank has partnered with Bhashini, an AI-driven language translation platform, to add local language support to their AI chatbot 'Feddy'. This collaboration is inspired by the local language banking initiative of RBI Innovation Hub (RBIH), which aims to make banking services more inclusive and accessible in India. Feddy will now be able to assist users in 14 Indian languages, such as Hindi, Bengali, Tamil, and Marathi.



6. Dharti Aaba Janjati Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan launched in Jharkhand.

The Union Ministry of Tribal Affairs has launched the "Dharti Aaba Janjati Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan", which aims to bridge the gaps in social infrastructure, health, education, and livelihoods in tribal areas through 25 schemes implemented by 17 central government ministries and departments.



7. Carlos Alcaraz beats world No. 1 Jannik Sinner in epic China Open final.

World No. 1 Jannik Sinner has got a challenging draw at the US Open 2024, where he could face heavyweights like former champion Carlos Alcaraz and Daniil Medvedev. Sinner will start his campaign against Mackenzie McDonald of the US. Defending champion Novak Djokovic, who emerged victorious by defeating Daniil Medvedev in last year's final, is in the same half this time with German player Alexander Zverev.



8. World Space Week | 4-10 October

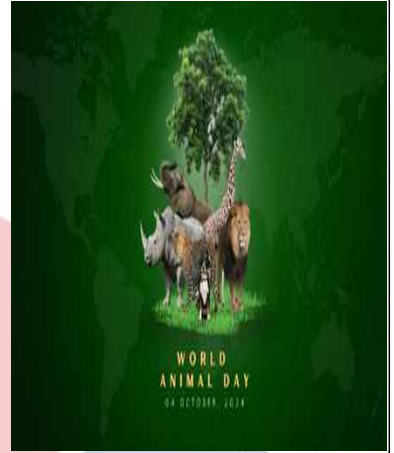
