1. Dia Mirza appointed as jury member of ALT Environmental Film Festival 2024.

Bollywood actress and environmental activist Dia Mirza has been appointed as a jury member of the All Living Things Environmental Film Festival (ALT EFF) 2024. The festival will be held from November 22 to December 8, 2024, showcasing 72 films, including 38 India premiere films. These films will focus on important environmental issues such as climate change and wildlife conservation.



2. Former radio presenter of Akashvani Darbhanga Indranand Singh Jha passes away at the age of 77.

Famous former radio presenter and director of Akashvani Darbhanga Indranand Singh Jha passed away at the age of 77 in his native village Chanaur, Darbhanga. He was popularly known as "Khur Khur Bhai" and gained immense popularity with his radio talk programme "Gamghar". His distinctive voice and engaging presentation style endeared him to listeners. Indranand Singh Jha's contribution was particularly significant in radio broadcasting.



3. Caste survey begins in Telangana, third in India.

Telangana has begun the process of caste-based census, becoming the third state after Andhra Pradesh and Bihar to do so. It aims to ensure targeted and equitable resource distribution among all communities, especially OBCs, SCs, STs and marginalised groups. This survey was one of the major promises made by the Telangana government in the assembly elections.



4. Launch of the first ship of the Multipurpose Vessel (MV) Project 'Sampark' at L&T, Chennai on 14 Oct 24.

The first ship of the two Multipurpose Vessel Project built by L&T Shipyard for the Indian Navy was launched on 14 Oct 2024 at L&T's Kattupalli Shipyard. The launch was done by Smt. Shashi Tripathi, President NWWA, in accordance with the maritime traditions of the Indian Navy.



5. NASA launches Europa Clipper to investigate Jupiter's moon.

NASA has launched the Europa Clipper spacecraft, the largest spacecraft ever built for any planetary mission. Its main objective is to investigate conditions favorable for life on Jupiter's moon Europa. The spacecraft will focus specifically on the vast subsurface ocean that lies beneath Europa's icy surface to determine if life is possible there.



6. Punjab government appoints Arvind Modi as chief adviser in finance department.

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP)-led Punjab government has appointed retired Indian Revenue Service (IRS) officer and former IMF senior economist Arvind Modi as chief adviser to strengthen the state's finance department. He will be given the status of a cabinet minister in this role. Modi has special experience in financial matters, including reviewing the Income Tax Act 1961 and drafting new direct tax laws.



7. President's rule lifted in Jammu and Kashmir after five years, Omar Abdullah-led government to take charge.

Preparations are in full swing for government formation after the assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir, and President's rule has been lifted after six years. The National Conference (NC) alliance won the elections with 49 seats, while the BJP got 29 seats. The last assembly elections were held in 2014, after which BJP and PDP formed a coalition government, but Mehbooba Mufti's government fell in 2018 after BJP withdrew support and President's rule was in force since then.



8. HAL becomes 14th Maharatna company.

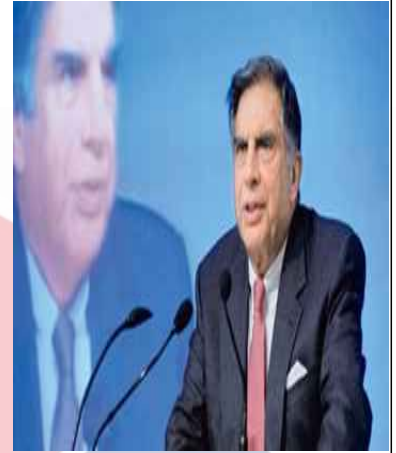
Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) received Maharatna status on October 12, making it the 14th Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) to be awarded this prestigious classification by the Government of India. With this new status, HAL has gained more operational autonomy and financial freedom. It can now invest up to 15% of its net worth and ₹5,000 crore in foreign projects without government approval.
