1. Famous actor Atul Parchure dies at the age of 57.

3. ISRO Chairman S. Somnath receives prestigious IAF World Space Award for Chandrayaan-3.

The award was given in recognition of the success of India's lunar mission Chandrayaan-3, which soft landed on the south pole of the Moon on 23 August 2023.
